Scholarship Detail

Dr. Anna Porter Burrell completed a Bachelor of Science degree in chemistry from the University of Pennsylvania in 1923. In 1926, she earned a Master of Science degree in Medical Sciences from her alma mater, the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Burrell's career path took her to Howard University in Washington, D.C., where she taught bacteriology.

Dr. Burrell came to Buffalo to teach at Buffalo State College in 1948. She was the first African American faculty member to be hired by the college. Dr. Burrell was appointed Director of the India Project at Buffalo State. She also served as the Director of Human Relations workshops. Dr. Burrell retired from Buffalo State in 1972.

The Dr. Anna P. Burrell Diversity Scholars Program is designed to enhance student diversity at Buffalo State College through supportive services, activities, and a campus environment that is highly conducive to high academic achievement.

To be eligible for the scholarship, candidates must:

- be a U.S. Citizen or an eligible non-citizen
- be a New York State resident
- be enrolled as a full-time undergraduate at Buffalo State College
- have achieved a minimum 85 percent high school average
- complete the 2018-2019 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)
- submit an essay on how they will make a contribution to the diversity of the student body in their program or on campus, primarily by overcoming a disadvantage or other impediment to success in higher education
- maintain a 3.0 cumulative GPA each semester
