Scholarship Detail

The Out-of-State Scholarship for Pennsylvania residents will provide annual awards of up to \$7,500 to first-time, full-time students. Candidate must be a Pennsylvania resident. Scholarship is renewable up to four years (8 semesters) and the scholars must maintain continuous enrollment. Scholarship is non-stackable with other philanthropically and institutionally funded scholarships. Scholarship will be awarded until the funding source is depleted.

Eligibility

- Must reside in the state of Pennsylvania only.
- Must be paying out-of-state tuition.
- Must be a new first-time student.
- Must be enrolled full-time (minimum of 12 credit hours).
- Must successfully complete 15-18 credits each semester (fall and spring).
- Must successfully earn a minimum of 30 credits each year.
- Must maintain good standing with college and a cumulative GPA of 2.5 to retain award
- Submit an essay (500 words limit; 12pt., Times New Roman font, double spaced) to describe your life, educational goals, and how Buffalo State College can contribute to your continued success.
