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- Your and your parents' Federal and State Income Tax Return from 2021 (IRS Form 1040 & IT-201).
- W-2 Forms from 2021 and any other records of money earned from working, for both you and parent.
- Your parents' marital status (married/separated/divorced) and the date (MM/YYYY).
- Your and parents' driver's license or government issued ID.
- Your and your parents' Social Security Numbers and dates of birth.
- Amount of child support your parent received or paid for 2021.
- Records of taxable earnings from Federal Work-Study or other need-based work programs, if applicable.
- Records of any grants, scholarships, and fellowship aid that was included in your or your parents adjusted gross income (AGI).
- Any current business and investment mortgage information, business and farm records, stock, bonds, and other investment records.
- Documentation that you are a U.S. permanent resident or other eligible noncitizen, if applicable.

Avoid delays in processing your aid, come to your appointment prepared!
